

Fun things to do in The Woodlands.

- [Texas Tree Ventures](#) is our local aerial adventure course that would be about a 15 minute drive from The Woodlands Resort.
- A fun thing to do while along the waterway is to rent kayaks, swan boats, paddle boards, or water bikes at [Riva Row Boat House](#).
- Spend an afternoon viewing local art in The Woodlands. We have a large collection of [Art Benches](#), many located along The Woodlands Waterway. Here is a link to more information about the [Art Bench Project](#) from The Woodlands Arts Council that includes a map of where they are installed.
- Another fun way to spend an afternoon is to hop on and hop off the complimentary [Town Center Trolley](#). The Trolley provides easy transportation along a 4.1-mile route connecting The Woodlands Mall, Market Street, The Woodlands Waterway, and Hughes Landing giving visitors easy access to retail and restaurants. Multiple trolleys will be in operation at a given time, to ensure wait times are at a minimum.
- A few restaurants along and around The Woodlands Waterway, there is something for every taste bud!
